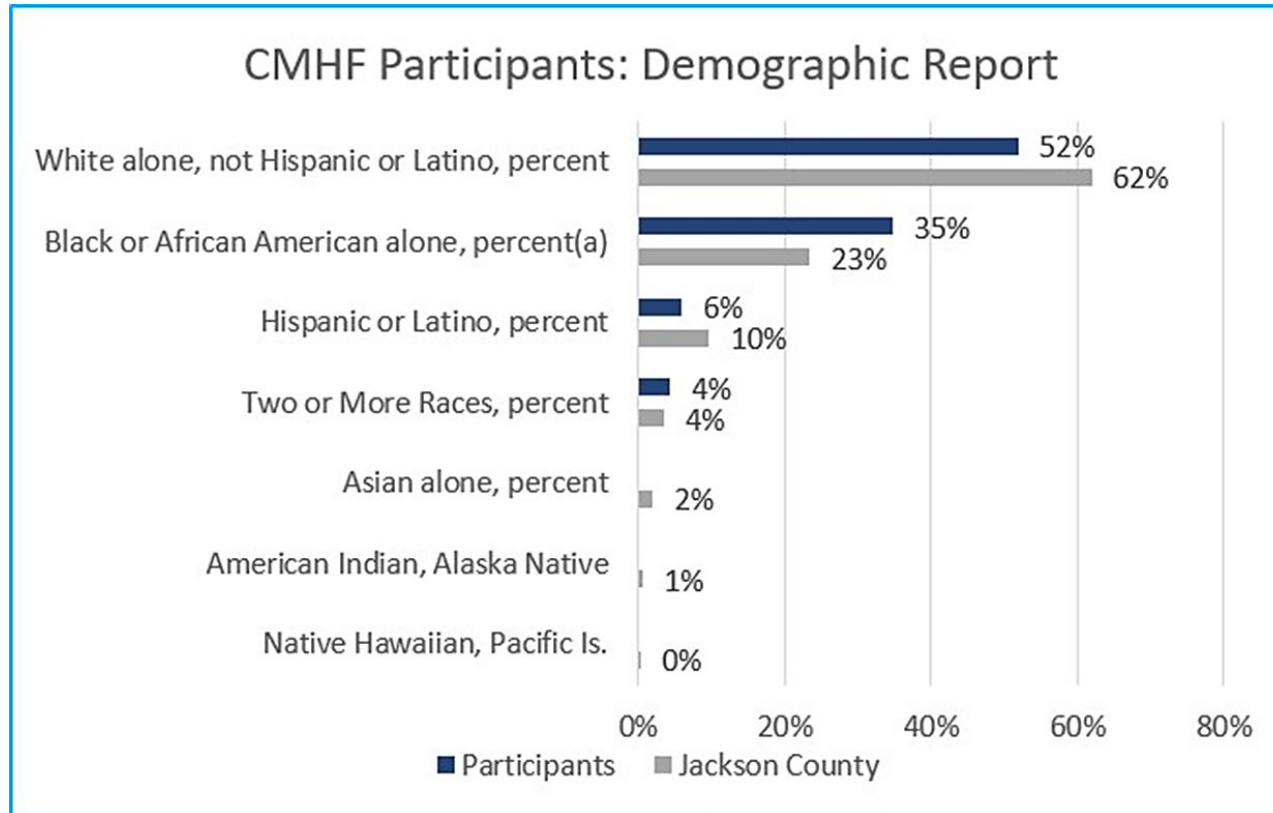

Comparison of CMHF Participants and Jackson County's population by race



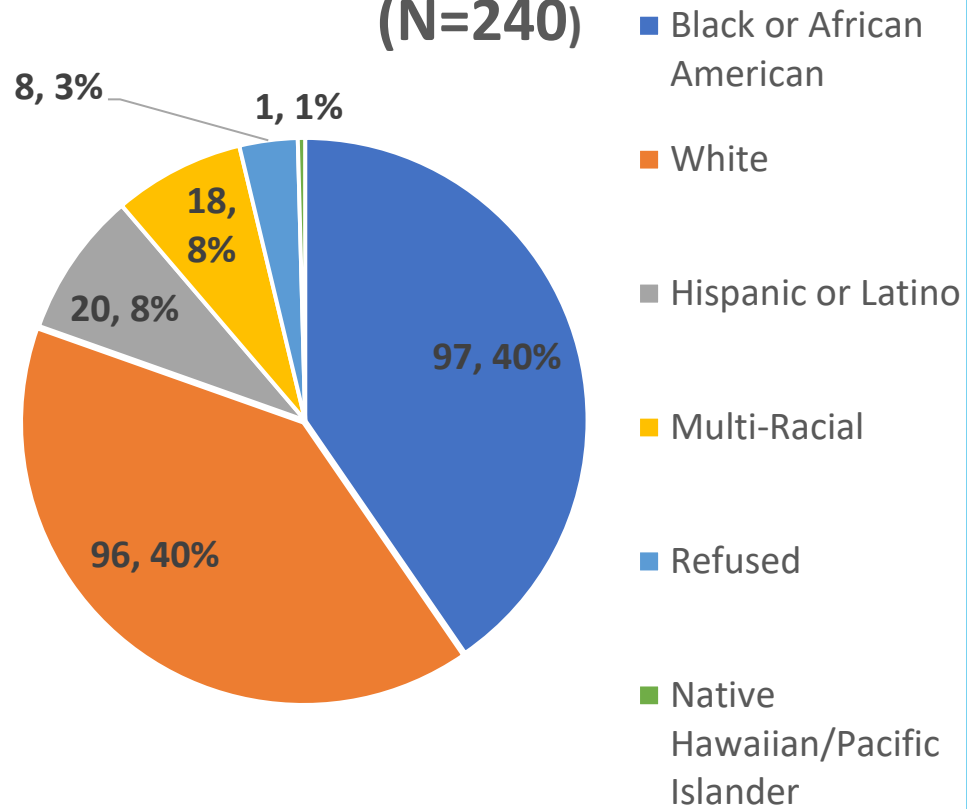
July 2021 Population of Jackson County, Missouri: 716,862

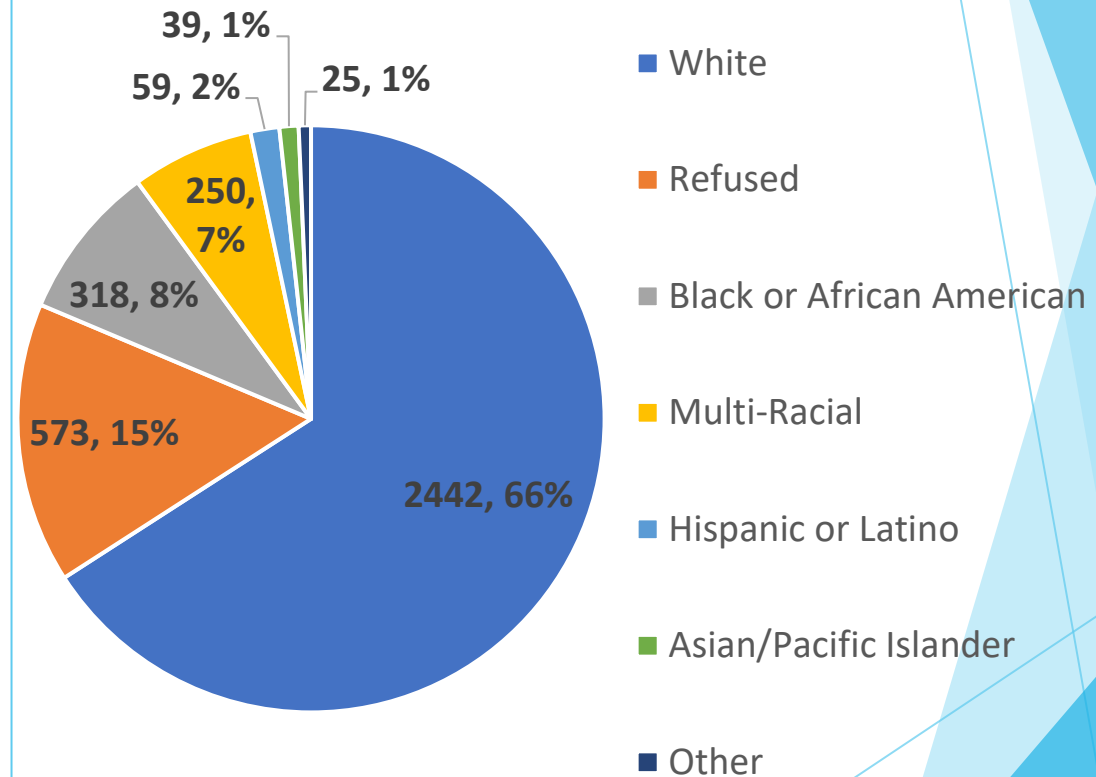


Participant race in 5 largest CMHF contracts

Cornerstones of Care (N=240)

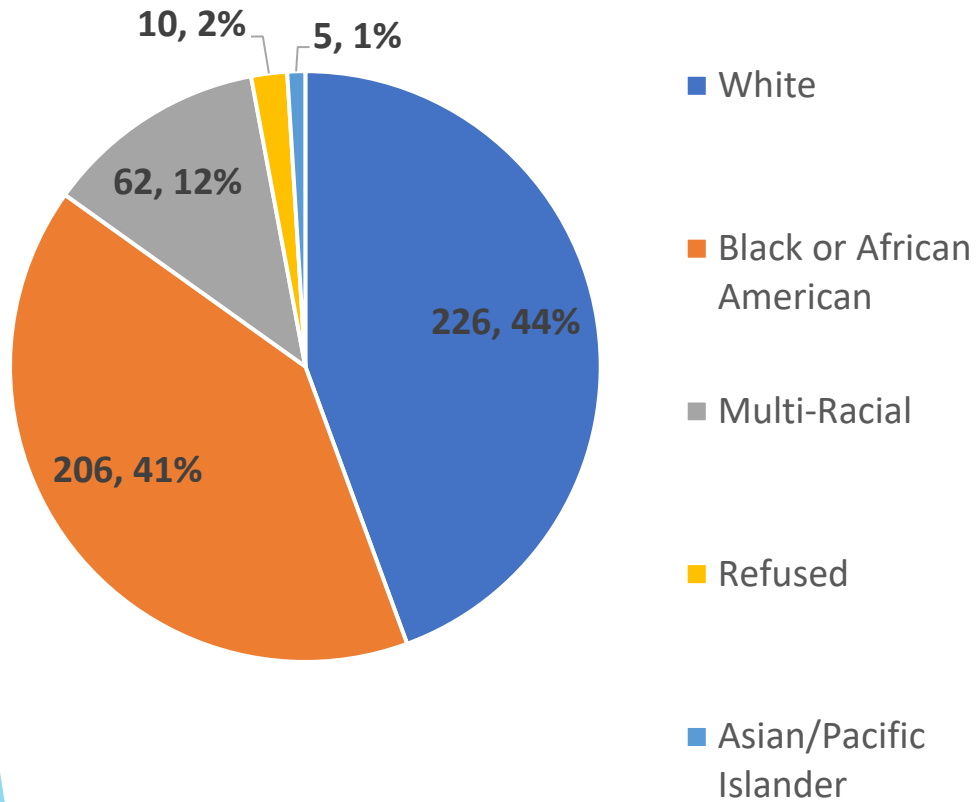

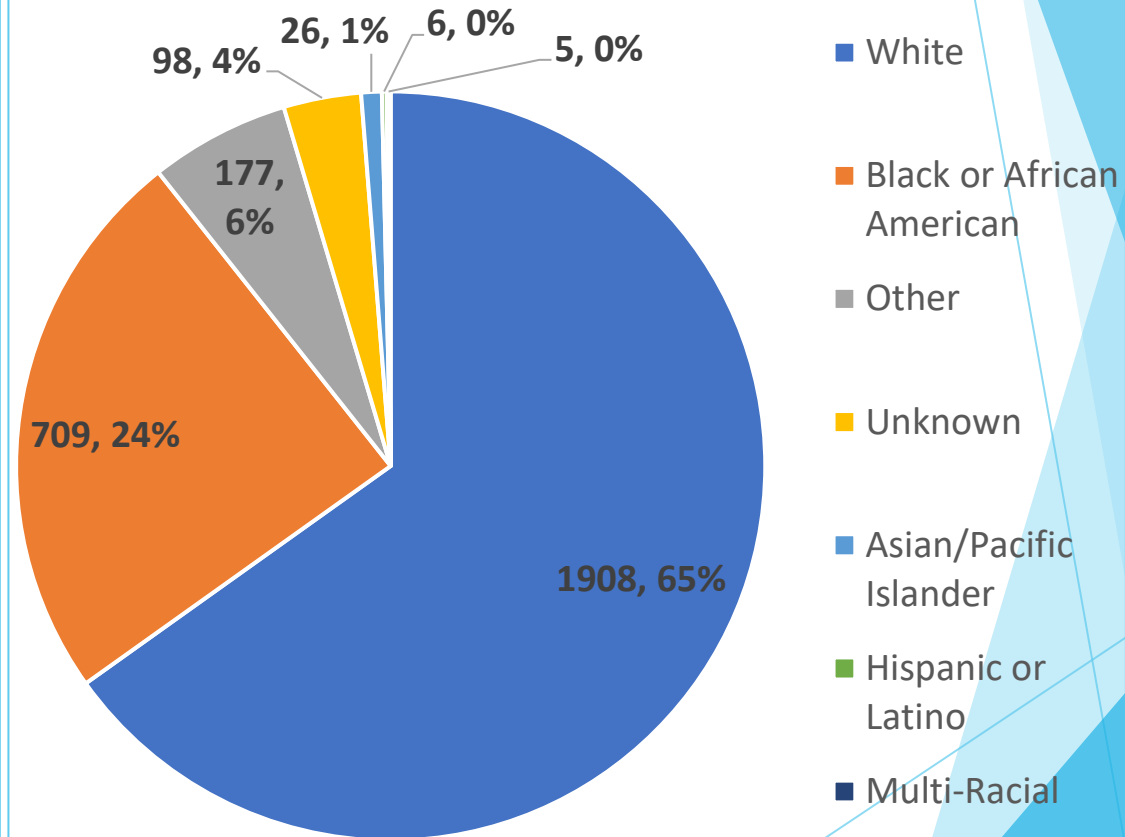

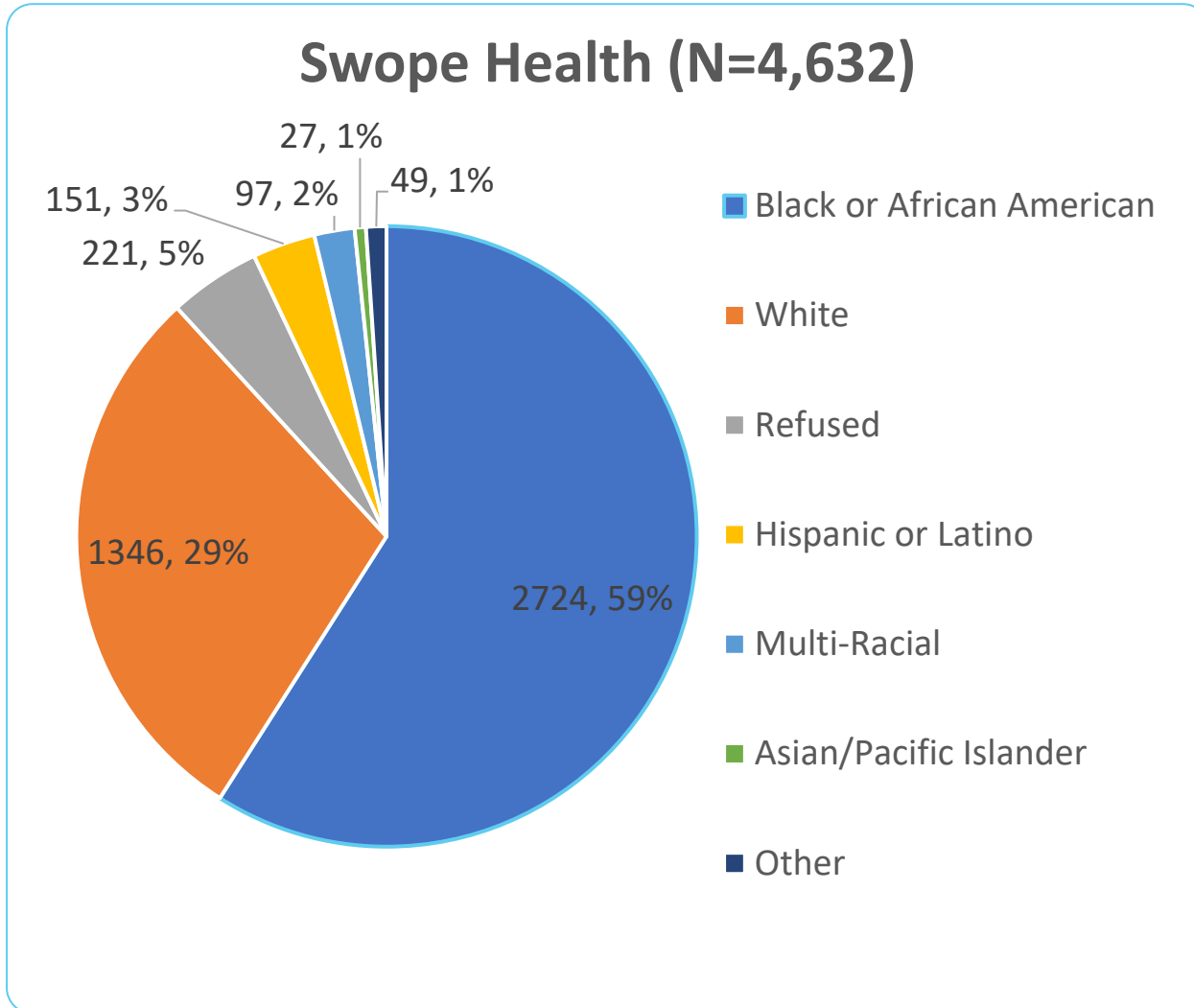

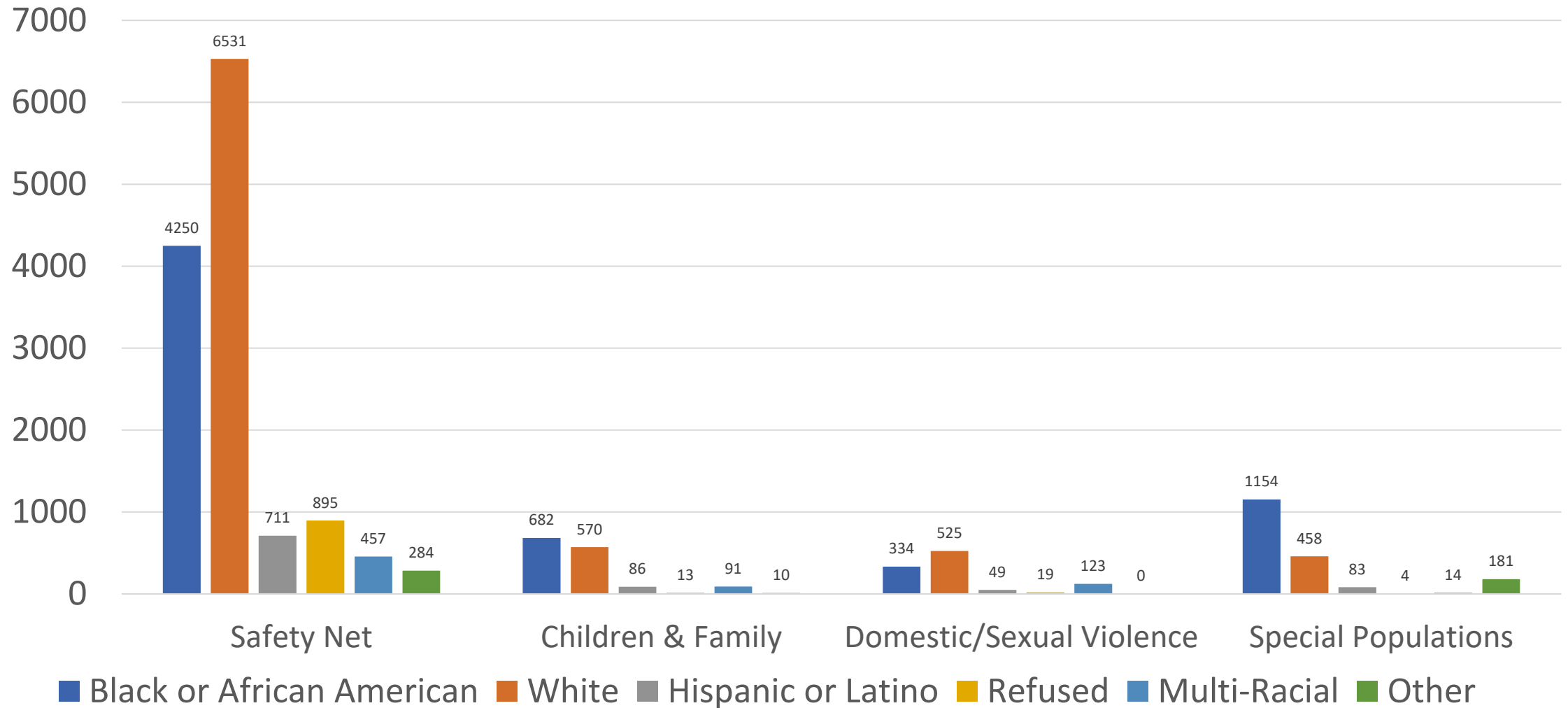

Participant race by grant category



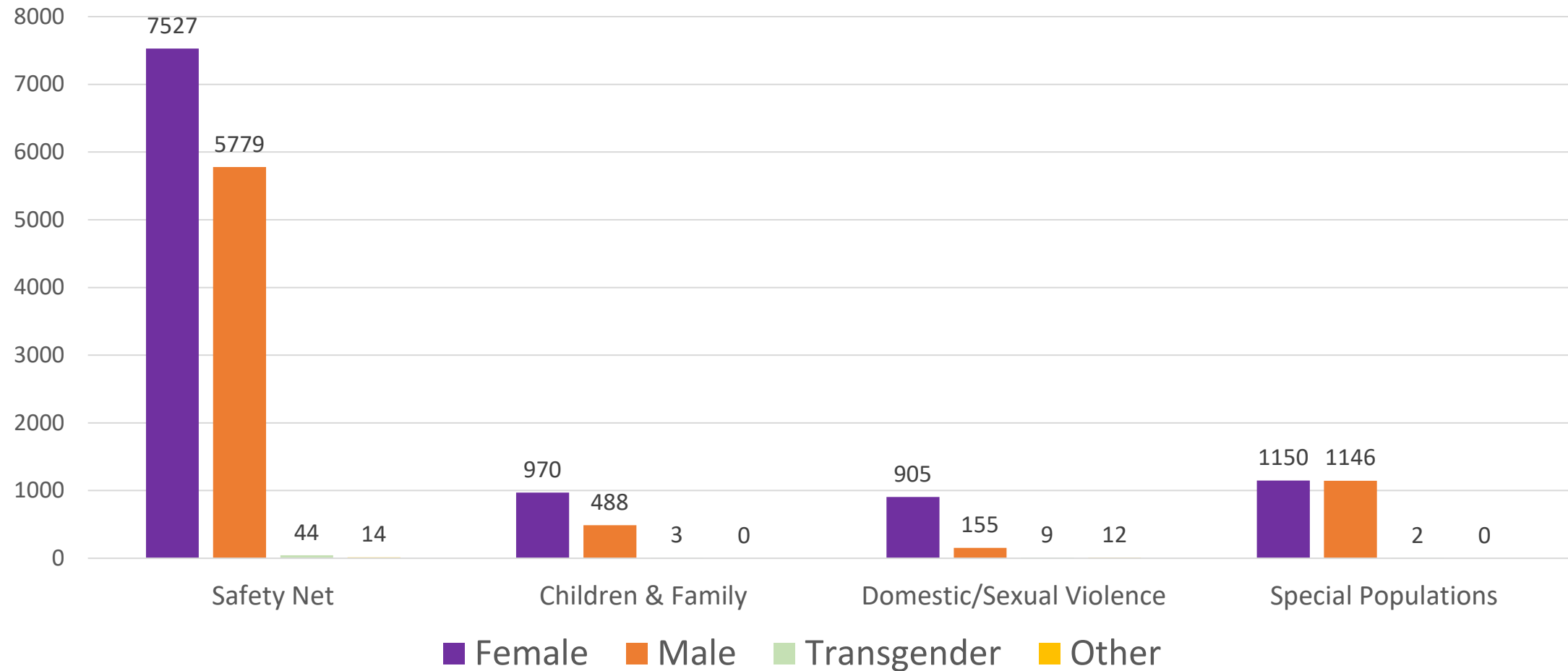

Participant gender by grant category

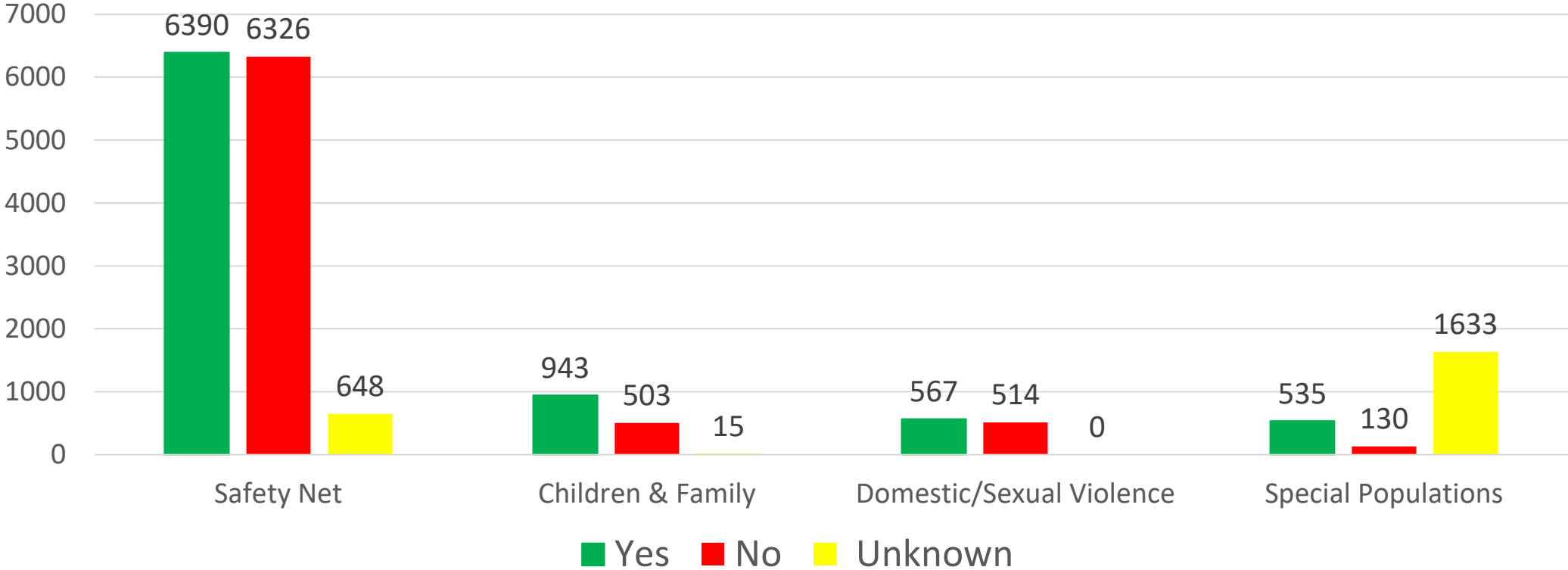

Participant insurance status by grant category

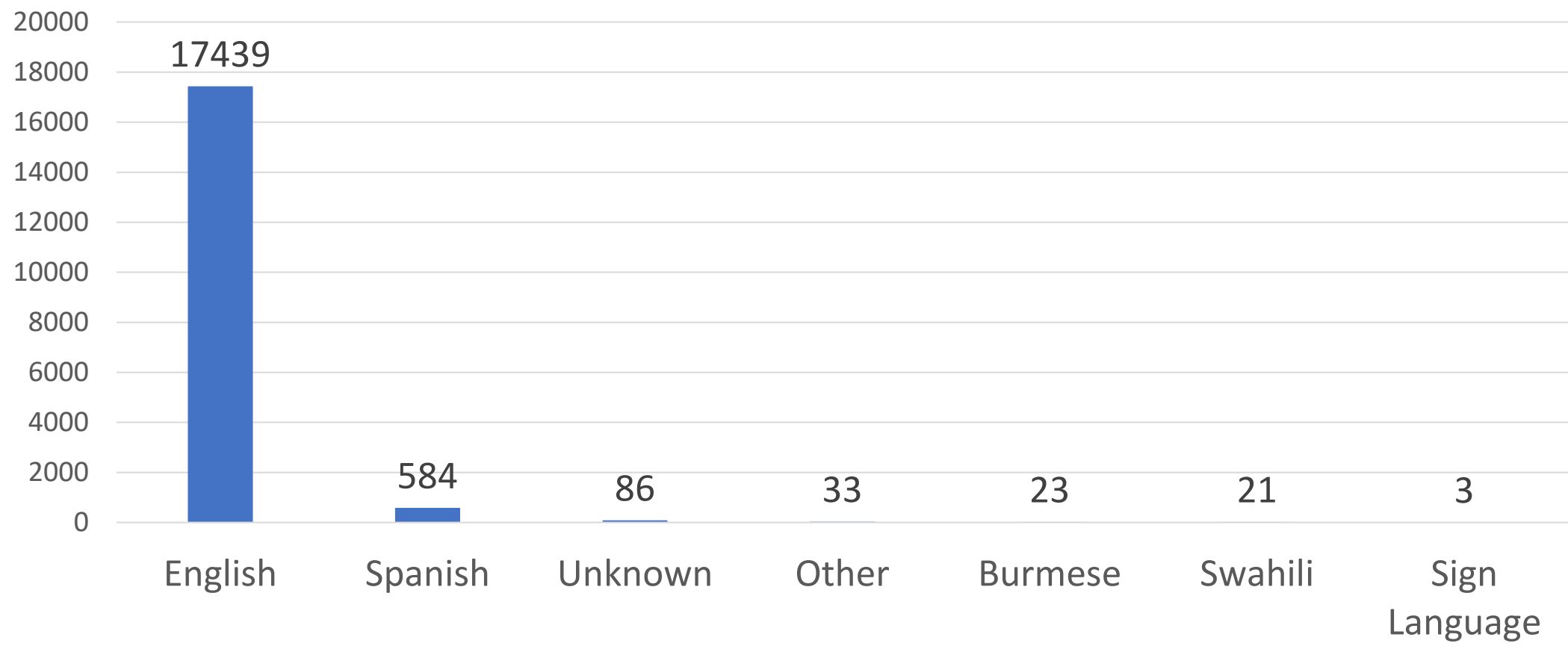
